Connecting Points

There's a high protein nutritional drink on the market that reminds me of what yesterday was for us at F.U.M.C.H. It's called Boost. Dr. Richard Hunter's presence and message was spiritually and emotionally nutritional. Some 30 years later the impact of this church on his life, faith and ministry were apparent. The Apostle Paul wrote to the Philippians' church that they were shareholders in the gospel and how their faith was paying dividends in other places through his ministry. He told them he held them in his heart or hugged them with his heart because they shared in his ministry. He knew that his experiences with them had empowered him and he was grateful for their partnership. Dr. Hunter invited us to continue to welcome the prodigal among us knowing that we can never know the full impact that our receptivity plays in kingdom work. How many people can one person we touch with love, touch for God?

We also benefited from his sharing with some of the leaders of our church. He shared that we are still a strong church and with prayer and discernment about our future ministries, we can make an even larger impact in this community for God. There was a time, he said, that you could build nice buildings, put comfortable chairs in them and pump in the A.C., and people would come. But now, we must go to them and build relationships and then they might come to our nice comfortable buildings. The good news is that there are many people around us with hopes and hurts and if we find new ways to meet them where they are, they will find Christ in and through us. Our Community Egg Hunt is one of the ways we go to them and you're invited to attend on Palm Sunday from 2-4. We will have an egg hunt but we are really hunting for people to connect with Christ and church family.

We got another boost from the team who rehearsed last night and will lead us in praise and worship this Sunday night at 6 p.m. Let's give thanks for all the ways that Jesus boosts us up and be in prayer for new ways to boost those around with God's love. After all, boost comes in many flavors!

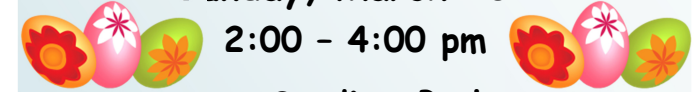
