Connecting Points

This year's sermon series and messages are based on the Common Lectionary Readings. We have two more sermons in connection with the "Hiking Lessons" series which are based on Jesus' Sermon on the Mount from Matthew's gospel.

During Lent our series is called "Eavesdropping" and we will overhear conversations between Jesus and others and not only learn from listening or tuning in to their exchanges but also become more aware of what people are talking about around us and how it helps to us to understand where people are spiritually and emotionally. Pastor John will preach a series for our noonday Holy Week services and our choir will lead us at our Maundy Thursday Service. I will tell the Palm/Passion Stories on Palm Sunday as our sermon for the day.

On Easter Sunday we will launch a series entitled "Believe It or Not!" It's interesting that at least one of the lectionary readings provided each week has the word "believe" in it. We will spend the season of Easter remembering what the Early Church and Christians believed and how what we believe impacts our lives in powerful ways.

On Pentecost Sunday, we will kick-off a series called "Wow!" These sermons will be about the theme of enthusiasm and help us see how the Holy Spirit inspires us to live with zeal and passion for God with others.

Joyful July will feature a variety of music as well as "One Verse" sermons about Prayers, Presence, Gifts, Service and Witness. We will also invite the whole congregation to tithe during this "One Month" and see the difference it makes. Our Outward area will lead us in "One Day" of service to our community and we will have "One Week" of ministry with the Kids at V.B.S.

Put this schedule on your refrigerator and pray about these and other way God will feed us spiritually at Hueytown First in the coming months.
