Connecting Points

Sunday, I shared that there's a lot of emphasis on the Holy Spirit these days in United Methodist Circles. My brother texted me about their Bishop in the Virginia Conference walking around while preaching and saying, "what we need most is to be full of the Holy Ghost!" I listened to Bishop Graves sermon of the Alabama-West Florida Conference and he spoke several times about our need for the power and presence of the Holy Spirit. Why, suddenly, is there all this talk about the need for the Holy Spirit in the life of believers and our denomination?

One of the reasons is that we are living in extremely challenging times. Our denomination is grappling with how to deal with our differences over human sexuality and there are many who believe we are either going to split into 2 or 3 entities or even worse, that we are going to completely fragment as a denomination and each church, like the Southern Baptist, will be autonomous. When you add the challenges of today's culture that include fewer people attending church and enormous burnout of pastors and church staff, you begin to see that all this is too big and even too hard for us as limited and finite creatures. But the good news is that it's not too hard or too big for God. So, we are seeking an outpouring of God's power through the Spirit of Jesus. The Spirit that empowered Him for ministry and mission in a complex and diverse world. Our desire is be renewed through the presence and power of the Holy Spirit and to remember that though we are many, there is one Spirit, one baptism, one faith and Lord of us all. To Him be glory in the Church and in our World, forever and ever. Amen.
