- Smile at the people you see.
 Smiling can increase our happiness level and make us more productive.
 Smile at those in your home more and then take your smile everywhere you go as a reflection of God's delight.
- Radiate grace.
 Bring levity to tense situations and help people who mess up so they know they are not alone.
- 3. Sing or hum throughout the day.

 Join the birds in singing your praise. Turn on the radio or plug in the iPod and hum to yourself. Create a joyful vibe and see how it affects others.
