Connecting Points

Yesterday, we started a sermon series at the Thrive Gathering about the Holy Spirit. I talked about how we often choose to be two-thirds trinitarian by leaving out the Holy Spirit. I showed how limiting that is by asking those present to choose only two aspects of what makes us human and made in God's image. For example, if you could only pick two from Body, Heart and Mind, which one would you leave out and live without? We also picked between Christmas, Easter and Pentecost. Many would choose to leave out Pentecost and go with the celebration of Jesus' birth and resurrection. So much for Pentecost, the birth of the Church and the gift of the Holy Spirit that Jesus promised! We remembered how the gift of the Holy Spirit made an enormous difference in the lives of the disciples both individually and collectively. Cowards became courageous in their bold witness and the Church is still here today because of the gift of Jesus' Spirit. Our failure to celebrate the Holy Spirit with us and in us is a huge oversight and one that needs to be recognized and addressed. It's the Spirit of God that makes the difference in you and me and God's Church. I invite you to remember God not only as our Father and Creator and not only as Son and Redeemer but also as Holy Spirit and Helper. Thanks be to God for the comfort, help, fruit, gifts teaching, conviction, empowerment and presence we experience through the Holy Spirit.
