John's Journal

Hello Friends in Christ! On Sunday, May 5, 2019, we celebrated Holy Communion as we heard the words of our Savior and Lord say, "Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you. Drink from this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins."

Resurrected Living as a Christ Follower is **'not just'** a commitment, it is a **WAY OF LIVING**. Does it take commitment? You bet it does! Living Resurrected in our thoughts, in our speech and in our actions is like living in a glass house – everything is always on display. But isn't that how Jesus Himself lived, always to the honor and glory of His heavenly Father?

I get it, we live in a world that desperately honors social status, power, principality, intelligence, measuring-up, and respect of achievement. And yet, Christ Followers are told to *focus on things above, set your hearts on things above, put to death whatever belongs to your earthly nature*. As Christ Followers we even believe these teachings until...until it means us! It's sobering in the world we live in to hear scripture tell us from 1 Timothy 6:6-7, "*But godliness with contentment is great gain. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.*"

On Sunday, May 12, 2019, our series on Living Resurrected will take a week break to make sure we give attention to honoring our Mother's on Mother's Day. On Sunday, May 19, 2019, we will conclude our Resurrected Living Series talking about "Acting Resurrected." The challenge will be to discover for ourselves how what we think spiritually, and how we articulate our spiritual beliefs are actually living themselves out in our service to God's Kingdom.

Colossians, chapter 3 reads:

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.
