July 27, 2020

Hello Friends of Jesus! Writing this week I want to remind each of us that beginning Sunday, August 2, 2020, our worship services at Hueytown F.U.M.C. will be returning to On-Line. I am hopeful that each of you are aware and will help us pass the word. For those who may just be learning of this news, the Senior Leadership (SPRC, Finance Chair, Finance Treasurer, Trustees, Lay Leader, Administrative Board Chair and both Pastors) met through messaging regarding the current COVID-19 circumstances. The Leadership in unanimous decision, decided that it was in the best interest of our congregational demographics to return to On-Line worship in August 2020. As you are so very aware, the ever-increasing numbers of COVID-19 cases are a real and present threat to demographic of attenders as an "at risk" population. Your leadership believes that we need to protect our people from any potential harm or risk of incidental infection.

As said, our worship services will return to On-Line only beginning August 2 2020. Worship Services will continue to be Livestreamed at both 10:00 a.m. for Traditional Worship, and at 11:11 a.m. for Modern Thrive Worship. The Leadership and I will be monitoring the numbers in our county area through August to determine what September 2020 will look like. We are committed though to making the best decisions possible that keep each of you safe, and hopefully, out of harm's way. We cannot thank you enough for your understanding as this was/is a very tough decision to make.

Looking ahead to August 2020, we will continue to host Awesome August, but only on August 16 th , 23 rd , and 30 th . Joel Henson, Choir Director, has scheduled an exciting time of worship through music on these three Sundays of August. Modern Worship will continue through August with normal services, but we are in the planning stage to hopefully offer at least one service likened to what we do in Traditional Worship during Awesome August. News to come in that respect.

1. Returning to Worship means Personal Responsibility. Come to Worship ONLY if you feel comfort-able doing so. If anyone feels uncomfortable about returning for Worship at this time, it's fine to STAY HOME. All services will be available on Facebook Live weekly. [Traditional Worship:](#) Hueytown First UMC; [Modern Worship:](#) Thrive Hueytown.
2. ENTER and EXIT points to the Sanctuary will be clearly marked. Please abide by the marked areas of entry and exit.
3. Sanitizing stations will be available for use as you enter and as you exit the church facilities. PLEASE USE THEM!
4. DIRECTIONAL walking paths will be clearly marked within the building and the Sanctuary. Please stay within the directional flow to keep all of us safe.
5. Available Restrooms will be clearly marked (not all restrooms will be usable). Restrooms must be sanitized by the user before exit for the next person (supplies provided). If you are unable to do such, notify an usher before entry to ensure sanitizing after use.
6. All In-Person worshipers are asked to wear their own protective facemask covering (unless otherwise instructed by doctor). There will be a limited number of disposable masks available.
7. Seating areas will be clearly marked for "6-foot distancing." Please abide by the marked seating.
8. Seating will be clearly marked to encourage "family togetherness." Please abide by the marked seating.
9. AT THIS TIME – there will not be a Community Coffee or Water Station available.
10. AT THIS TIME – refrain from handshakes, fist-bumps, hugs, etc. We will not have a formal greeting time in worship.
11. AT THIS TIME – there will be no "bulletins/orders of worship." Worship information will be on the screens.
12. AT THIS TIME – there will be no common offering plates passed. Please use the identified "Offerings" basket either when entering or exiting worship.
13. AT THIS TIME – Holy Communion will be served through pre-packaged elements. Logistics still being discerned at this time.
