JOHN'S JOURNAL

Hello Hueytown First Members and Friends! I pray that each of you took advantage of the Memorial Day weekend to give thanks to all the fallen Heroes of freedom. Not only did we in the last week give thanks to those heroes, we on Sunday, June 6, 2021, remembered the 75 th anniversary of D-day...the storming of Normandy. It would be an understatement to say that our freedom stands on the lost lives of so very many men and women of wartime. Again, I share a word of appreciation and thanks to all that have died for that freedom, and to all that fought for that freedom!

A few updates are needed this week on things going on at Hueytown First UMC: first, thanks to Bro. John Simmons for bringing us God's word, and celebrating Holy Communion on Sunday, June 6, 2021. Secondly, thanks again to the S.P.R.C. (announced last week) in the hiring of Michael Edmonson to lead the Modern Worship Service – Thrive. Sunday, June 6 th was Michael's first Sunday. Congratulate Michael the next time you see him. Also, offer a word of appreciation and thanks to Catherine Verciglio who was asked by SPRC to lead the service during the search time. It was her second stint covering transition into new leadership. Third, I was contacted by Brad Hinton last week to say that the perimeter work on the walking track is complete. What is needed now is some hands and feet from the congregation to do some tidy-up raking and rubble removal that only hands and feet can do. Can you help? Will you help? That work can start as soon as possible. The work needed would be as if you were clearing up; straightening up; detailing if you will, sidewalk work or flower bed type work.

Lastly, but by no means less important than what has already been noted in updating you this week, Bill Hornsby and I attended the 2021 Annual Meeting of the North Alabama Conference of the United Methodist Church on Friday and Saturday of last week. The meeting was held Virtually by Livestream. Maybe the most notable matter this year was that we will be served by Bishop Debra Wallace-Padgett another year as our Bishop, but Bishop Padgett will also be serving as an "overseer Bishop" in the Holston Conference. There were four bishops in the Southeast Jurisdiction retiring, and the Book of Discipline requires in-person meeting to elect new Bishops. The next Southeast Jurisdiction meeting is Fall 2022, thus four current Bishops, including our Bishop, were assigned oversight of the retiring Bishop's Conferences. With regard to the meeting of the General Conference of the United Methodist Church, our Bishop relayed again that it is scheduled for August-September 2022, Minneapolis, Minnesota. It is there that the Protocol of Separation will be voted upon by delegates from around the world of The United Methodist Church.

Friends, don't forget...it is my hope and prayer that we are embracing with a sweet spirit and a supple heart the impact of our being led by the Holy Spirit. We are to give our very best of time, talents, gifts, skills, abilities and resources to making disciples of Jesus Christ. It means that we choose to live with intentionality having the mind of Christ, speaking as Christ would speak, having a heart like Christ, and hands/feet that seek to serve rather than be served. It is for the congregation of Hueytown F.U.M.C., A Charge to Keep I (we) Have.

Friends of Jesus...I continue to look forward daily in what God continues to do through our great church in 2021 as we answer our calling from God, A Charge to Keep I (we) Have...it will take all of us...this generation to serve!
