As I write to you this week, it is the morning after Sunday, October 29th's Administrative Board Meeting. Three matters needed the Board's attention: 1) setting of the Pastor's salary for the upcoming year (it will remain the same as 2023, no change); 2) approving the Nomination Teams work for Laity Leadership going into 2024 (copies available in the Narthex/West Entrance/Church Office); and 3) receipt of a motion from the MOVING FORWARD TEAM to propose changing the Traditional Worship Service time from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. All three pieces of business were approved by the Administrative Board.

What seems a most obvious question is related to the change in Traditional Worship time. A motion was presented and approved to move **Traditional Worship to 10:00 a.m. beginning Sunday, January 7, 2024**. The preceding sentence was the end-result of an original motion made on Sunday afternoon.
