Greetings Friends! I pray that you are doing well today as you receive this weeks Newsletter. It's my hope and prayer that you are feeling God's presence through our Lenten preaching and teaching theme of "The Heart Matters." Selfishly, it has offered my heart much growth in this season thus far. Who would have thought how much influence the heart has in how we do, and in some situations, don't live out God's calling daily. It really is no surprise that Jesus taught us in Matthew 6:21, "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." It's important to recognize in His teaching that our hearts tend to follow what we seem to value. It causes me to ask, "what do I value?" You? I lift us up to continue striving to observe a Holy Lenten season by participating in the Spiritual Disciplines of Worship, Prayer, Fasting, Study, Giving, Serving and Fellowship.

As I write on this Monday, March 11 th, the re-paving and repair work on our church parking lot has started. We anticipate good weather most of the week, which lends toward a completion of the project. BUT...we need to be aware that problems usually arise. Thank you for being FLEXIBLE THIS WEEK as our lot is worked on.

Let me share please...folks are asking, how are we paying for the project? The bid for the project came in at \$59,500. The Finance Team/Administrative Board in 2023 approved the use of \$34,500 from a Money Market Account to be used for the project. The Childcare Center is contributing \$15,000 on the project as well. The balance the church needs to pay is \$10,000 +/-. The church has received some capital contributions, the November 2023 Yard Sale was a great success, as was the July 2023 'We Are America' program...all produced funds toward Capital Projects, which includes the Parking Lot. The parking lot will be paid in full at its completion.

Let me continue to share...As you know, we've had some Capital repairs all throughout 2023, and some of the Capital Funding raised and/or given in 2023 has supported paying for those projects, along with designated funding for such projects. All in all, as Stewards of all that God has blessed our lives with, it is a time God calls on us to make an Easter Offering toward Capital Needs and setting up a Capital Reserve for needs. Friends of Jesus, this isn't an Easter Offering where we rationalize that we have some "given debt" that needs to be paid and we'll give some proportion of gifting, it is a moment where we offer God a free will gift based on The Heart...your heart, my heart, our hearts. Might I boldly suggest...Don't overthink this; don't think there is some secret project someone at church wants done without sharing; don't say, 'I've done my part'; don't lean into suspicion of 'what's the money for?'...JUST TRUST YOUR HEART TO MAKE AN EASTER OFFERING GIFT. I'll tell you what it's for...It will be used for Capital needs now, and upcoming capital needs of God's Church, your church home. Lisa and I are giving a gift this week! Just open your heart to God's blessings, and offer! Give your gift to: EASTER OFFERING!
