Hello Friends of Jesus!

Greetings in the Name of Jesus! If I write the words, "Well, where does one start...," to start the Newsletter, and branch into a writing this week, that would be dishonest. In fact, you and I know where all things start...with Jesus Christ. And that too is just too rote to say, isn't it?

Conditions in the world that we live in, with regard to humanity's treatment of each other, seems to be at an all-time low. Over the past weekend, the local news stations in our county reported seven murders in Jefferson County, and we know too well the events in Pennsylvania on Saturday, July 13th, with an attempted assassination of former President Donald Trump. Do Not Go all Political on me right now! This is a human problem, not a political problem.

Let me simply say this week, you and I as Christ Followers need to be at the top of our Spiritual Lives in sharing the Love of Jesus Christ with all we meet. Our lives should be nothing short of a living example toward a transparency that the Holy Spirit of Jesus lives in and through us. I am praying that you and I will look to our daily living as a chance in every moment to not only be an example of God's love in Jesus, but that we will be the physical hands and feet of Jesus as we serve God by serving others.

I want to challenge each of us this week to learn a scripture text that can aid each of us in remembering and practicing the disposition of Jesus in our daily living. It comes from Galatians 5:22-23, and reads, "22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law." The words of Paul's writing to the community in Galatia are meant to say that this is who we are because of a relationship with Jesus. They are nouns! They speak to the type of person people should encounter in us who claim the Name Christian. It will always be so much easier NOT to work spiritually in being this type of reflection of Christ. This takes work, and we aren't always in the mood to live as Christ. We might remember at this time that it was Christ that said to His Heavenly Father, "not my will, but thine be done."

In our day, time and culture that needs the working of the Holy Spirit through God's people for a Spiritual Holy Movement, I am hopeful that your prayer, my prayer, our prayer as a congregation is, "Do it again through me Lord, Do it again through me!"
