Sharing Good News!

In my devotional reading this past week, January 10th, I read words shared by Henry and Richard Blackaby. Henry Blackaby was the long-time teacher of the bible study, Experiencing God. His son Richard has also carried on the teaching of his father through a devotional by the same name. The following was my reading: *"Whenever Jesus spoke, what He said came to pass. Lepers found that a word from Jesus meant healing (Lk. 5:13,17:14). The blind man discovered that a word from Jesus meant sight (Lk. 18:42). Through a barren fig tree the disciples saw that a curse from Jesus meant destruction (Mk. 11:20). The sinner experienced forgiveness through a word from Jesus (Jn. 8:11). How many attempts did it take Jesus to raise Lazarus from the dead? Only one (Jn. 11:43). There was never a time that Jesus spoke that what He said did not happen.*

What happens when Jesus speaks to you? Have you been reading the words of Jesus in your Bible without experiencing His Word that transforms everything around you? Pharisees assumed knowledge of the written Scriptures...they were satisfied with having the words instead of experiencing the Person who spoke the words (Jn. 5:39)."

How about you, me, us? Are we SATISFIED just knowing the words...of Scripture? Or are you, me, us...yearning to know the Master of the Word...experiencing God? Being transparent, it seems these days that my spiritual life has such a hunger for God's word. I'm looking for insight, I'm looking for nourishment, I'm looking for answers, I'm looking for guidance, I'm looking for His will for my life/His church/my family.... I am so very hopeful that you too are seeking to know Jesus as you study His word. God is a good, good God! God is loving! God is compassionate! God is self-revealing through His love letter to us...His word! Take time to read it friends!

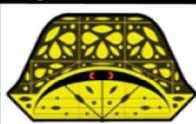
